**The following is taken from Mary Sheely's 1976
Ottawa History,**

**“The fallen and scattered head stones with almost
illegible names of Row, Galbreath, Owens,
Ridenour, and Adgate attest to the foothold in
change which was the beginning of Ottawa.” In
later years attempts and saving the cemetery make
no mention of an Owens burial, which must have
disappeared in the 80's and 90's. Hopefully future
efforts can provide some information on the
Owens burial”.**

**Since number lot No. 35 is listed, there must have
been at least 35 burials, but we only have limited
information on 21 burials**
